WHAT: Students will get an appetizer in a career field where they can touch, feel & use equipment and tools used for a variety of jobs, complete experiments and use simulators to wet their appetite for a particular career.

- WHY: The goals are:
 Present 8th graders a variety of menu choices for careers.
 - Give them a taste of tools, equipment, skills, etc. in each career field presented using hands-on experiences.
 - Show students do not have to go far to have a meaningful and rewarding career. There is a wide variety of choices in their own back yard.
 - Help the student chart a path in high school exploring those careers further with dual credits, job shadows, internships, work experiences etc.

- Laser system, CNC machine, Co-bot/robotics with conveyor belt





Voting centers include City Hall (416 Walnut St) or Fire Station #2 (201 W 23 rd St).




