
Workforce Map







Light Hiring Competition Over an Average Supply of Regional Talent




Supply (Jobs)

Yankton County, SD is about average for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 349* employees, while there are 364 here.



Earnings Per Job

Competition from online job postings is low in Yankton County, SD. The national average for an area this size is 12* job postings/mo, while there are 3 here.



Supply Is About Equal to the National Average







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Retirement Risk Is High, While Overall Diversity Is Low

Racial Diversity


Racial diversity is low in Yankton County, SD. The national average for an area this size is 123* racially diverse employees, while there are 35 here.

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.




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






