Opt Out Reduction of \$950,000!

In February of 2020 voters in the Yankton School District approved an Opt Out for a maximum annual sum not to exceed \$1,850,000.

During the Opt Out discussions three years ago a promise was made to reduce the Opt Out amount needed for the General Fund if there was an opportunity to do so at any time.

The Yankton School Board unanimously approved a **\$950,000 dollar reduction** in the Opt Out needed for the 2023-24 General Fund Budget at the September School Board Meeting.

The reduction was due to Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief funds, increased enrollment, budget to actual expenditures and financial stewardship.

The Yankton School District kept their promise to reduce the Opt Out given there was an opportunity to do so for the current budget year. The \$950,000 reduction represents half of the maximum annual sum approved by voters.

We are thankful to our community for their on-going support and trust in the Yankton School District.
