CO.STARTERS is a 10-week, cohort-based program that equips entrepreneurs of all kinds with the

insights, relationships, and tools needed to turn ideas into action. Participants enter into a facilitator-led, collaborative process with a small and supportive group of 10-15 like-minded peers. Over ten sessions, they develop and fine-tune their ideas, critically examining every part and determining next steps.
