Yankton Thrive is Excited to Bring the CO.STARTERS Business Accelerator Program to the Yankton Area!

CO.STARTERS is a 10-week, cohort-based program that equips entrepreneurs of all kinds with the insights, relationships, and tools needed to turn ideas into action. Participants enter into a facilitator-led, collaborative process with a small and supportive group of 10-15 like-minded peers. Over ten sessions, they develop and fine-tune their ideas, critically examining every part and determining next steps.

This program is offered in partnership with Start-Up Sioux Falls, Dakota Resources, and the Small Business Administration (SBA). The CO.STARTERS business accelerator program is currently supported through the Community Navigator Pilot Program grant, powered by the SBA. The current price of the program is free (regular price \$600).

CO.STARTERS starts Monday, June 6, from 8:30-11:30AM. In-person sessions will be held at the Thrive Welcome Center (803 E 4th Street). Aspiring entrepreneurs or seasoned entrepreneurs looking to launch a new product or service are encouraged to apply.
