The South Dakota Department of Labor and Regulation (DLR) has launched a competitive application process for the Pathway Partnership Initiative to build **High School Registered Apprenticeship Programs (RAP)**.

DLR is seeking applicants to take on a leadership role in the sponsorship, development, and implementation of comprehensive career pathways. Leaders for this initiative include, but are not limited to:

- Businesses and industry/employer partners,
- Post-Secondary Institutions (technical colleges, universities, other post-secondary education), and
- Secondary Education Institutions (high schools).

This initiative is a one-time grant opportunity. Up to four (4) awards will be granted in the amount of \$35,500 each on a contractual basis. Awardees of this initiative will be provided initial and ongoing technical assistance and support from DLR Apprenticeship Coordinators.
