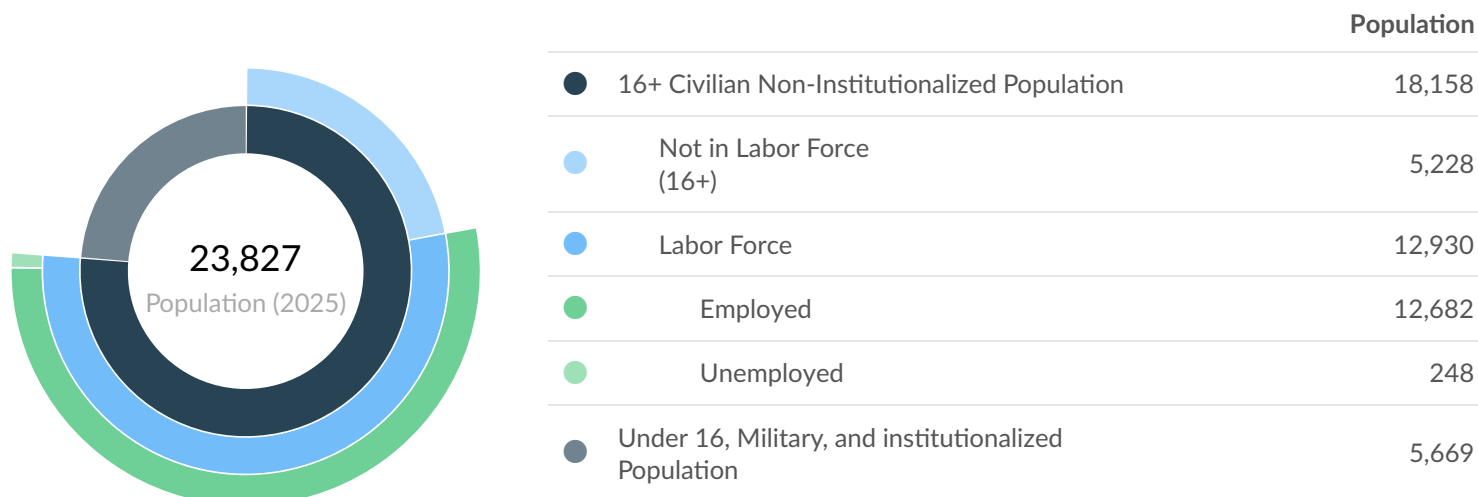
Median household income is **\$4.7K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

## Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 3.7%** since 2019, growing by 854. Population is expected to **increase by 2.4%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 566.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 2.0%** in Yankton County, SD from 14,305 to **14,597**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 70.9% to 69.1% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.7% of Yankton County, SD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.8% below the national average), and **12.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

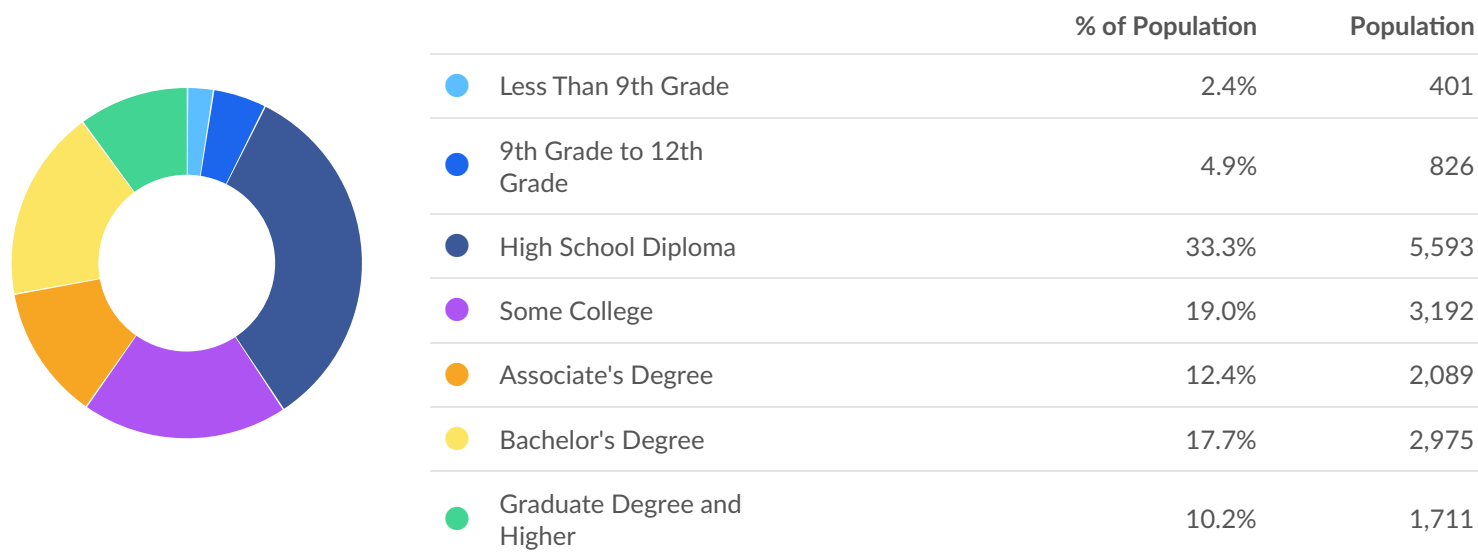

## Jun 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



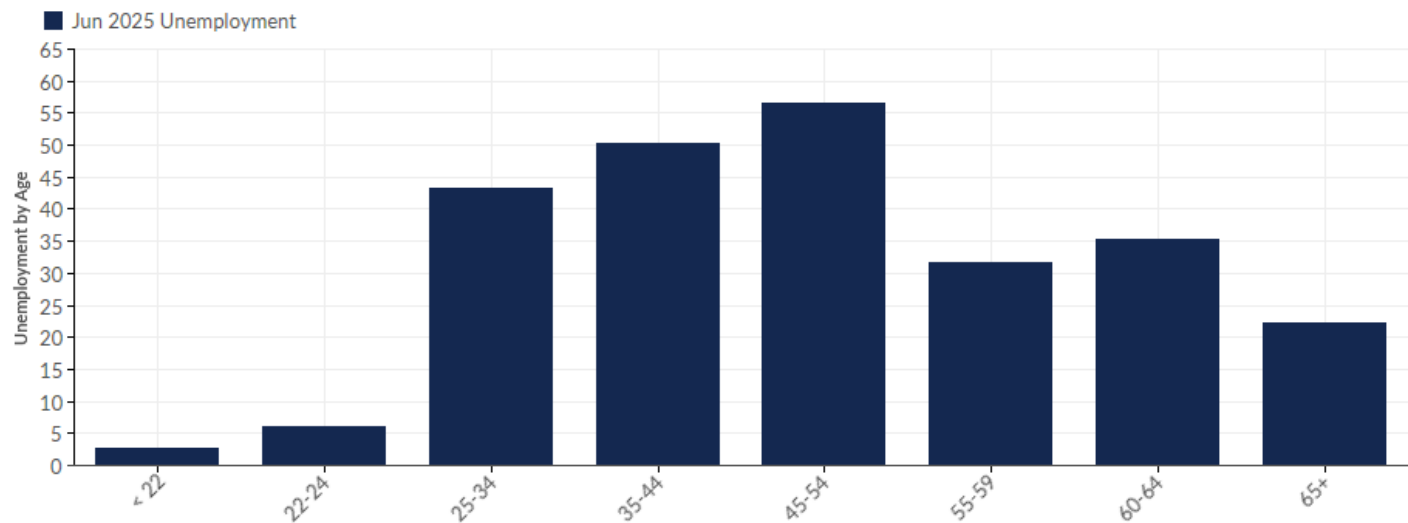
## Educational Attainment

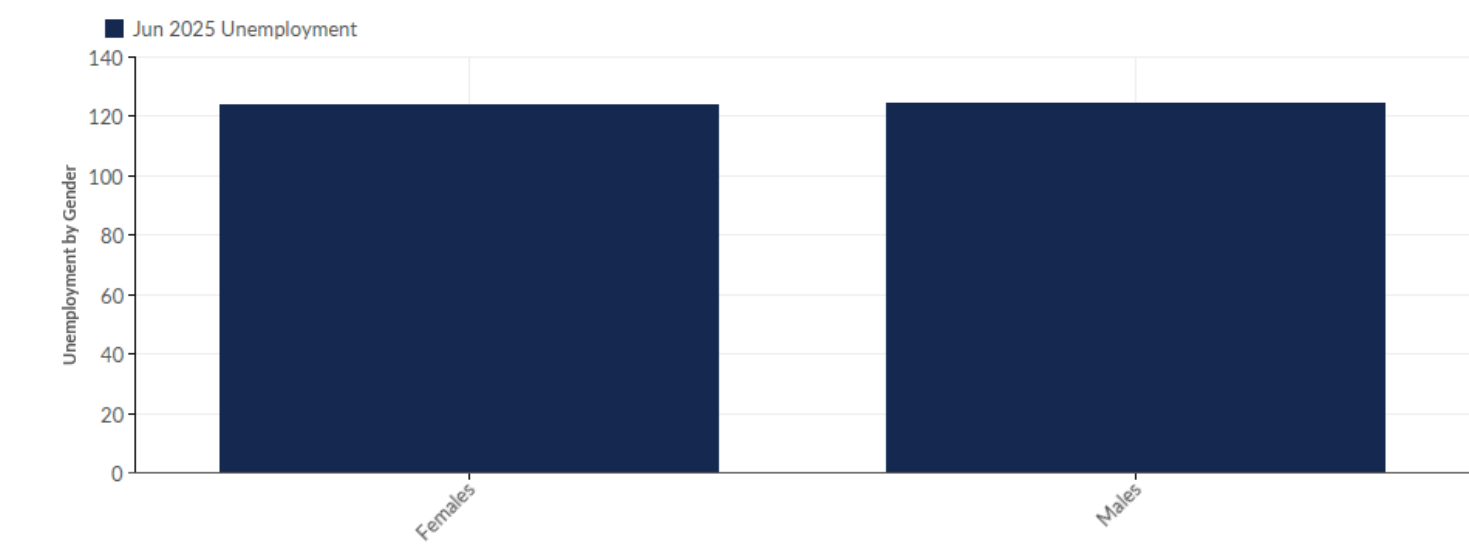

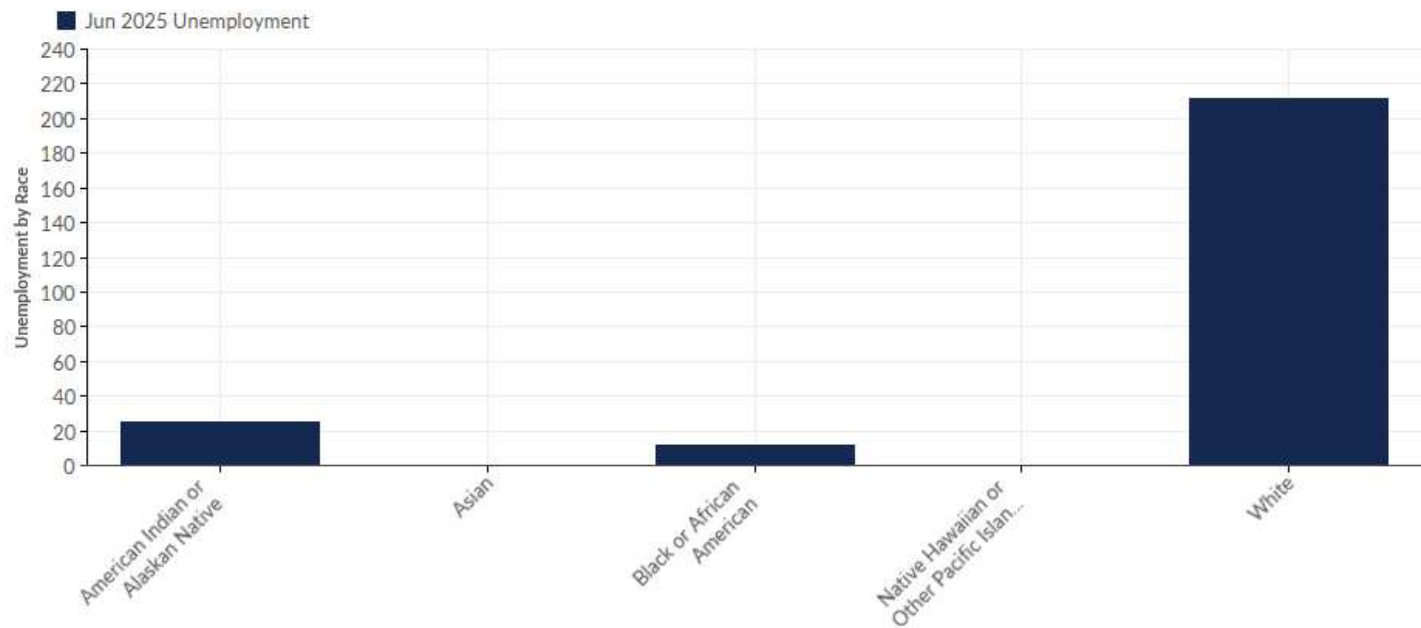

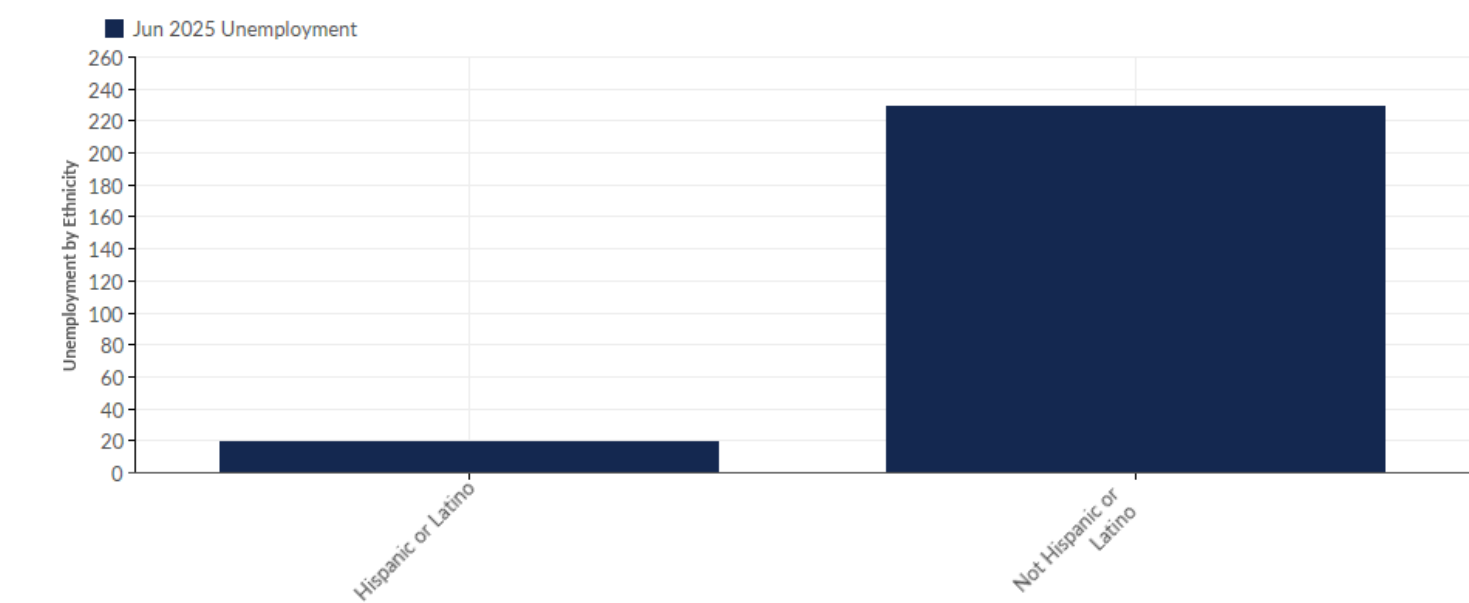

Unemployment by Ethnicity

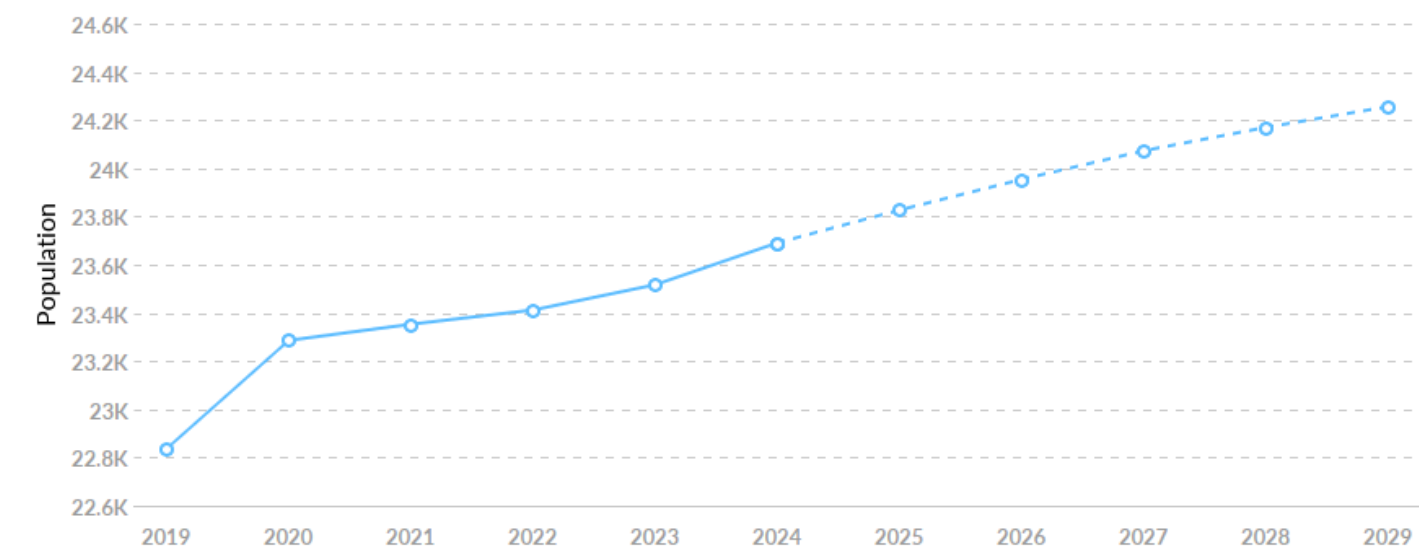

## Population Trends

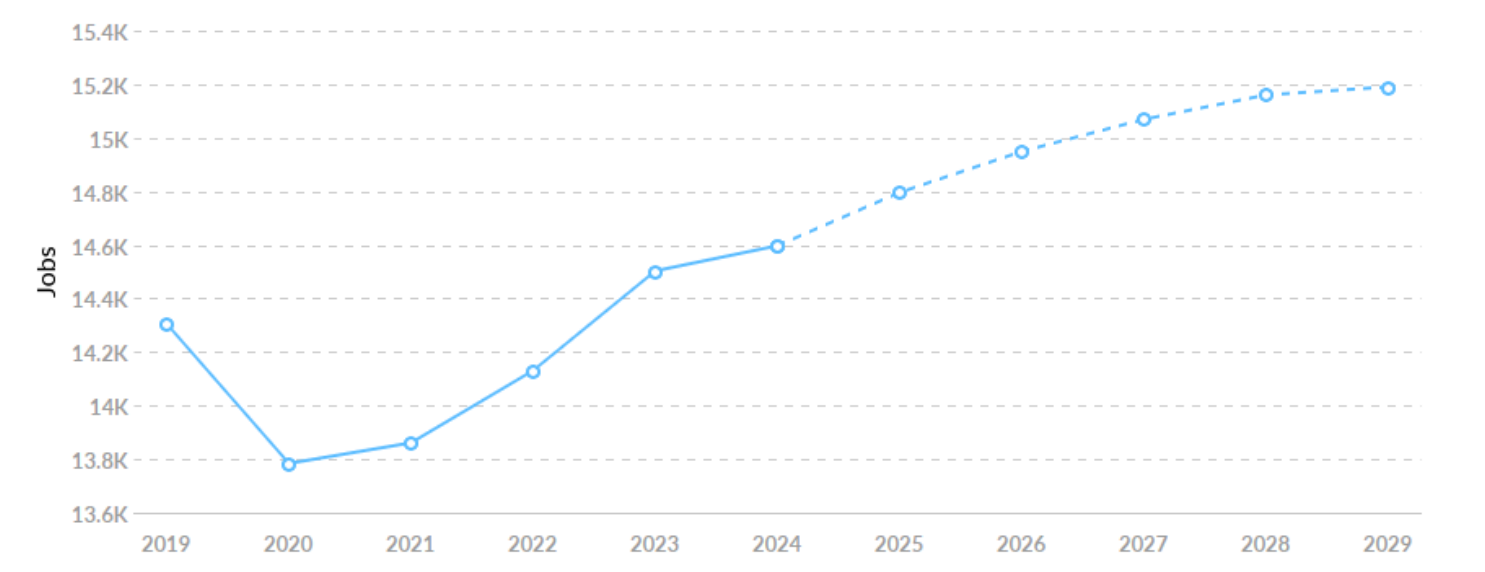

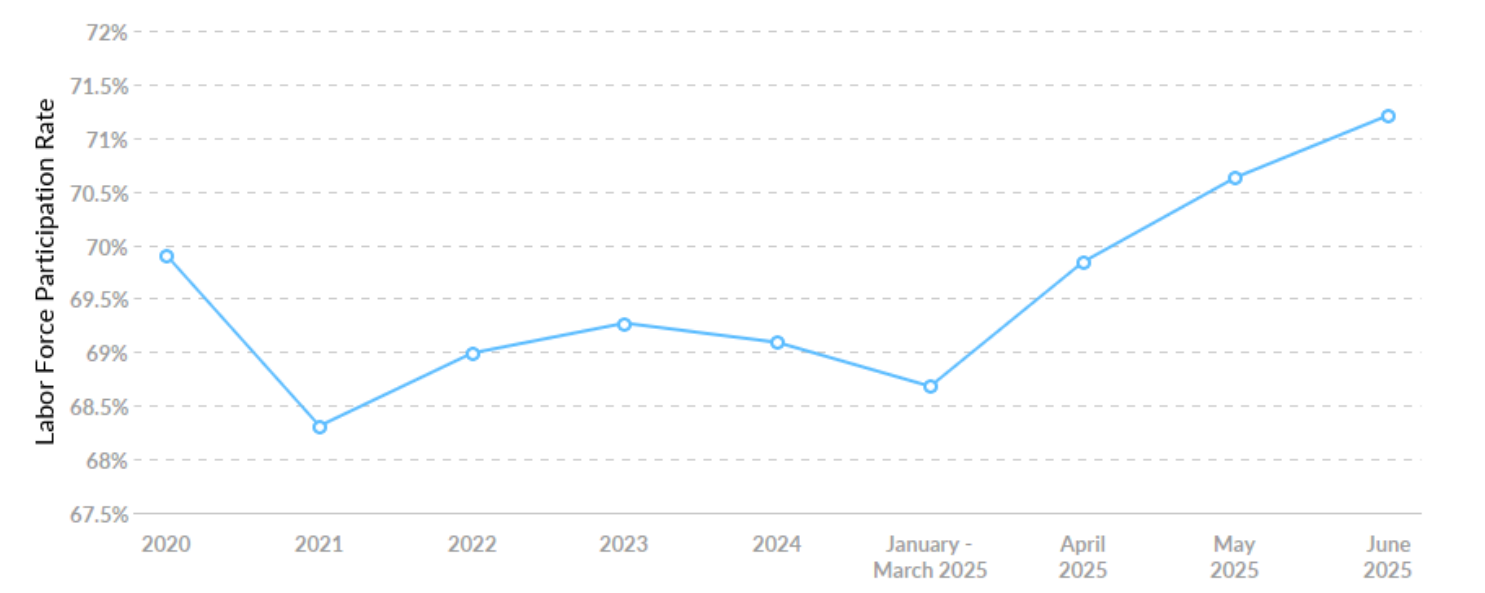
## Job Trends

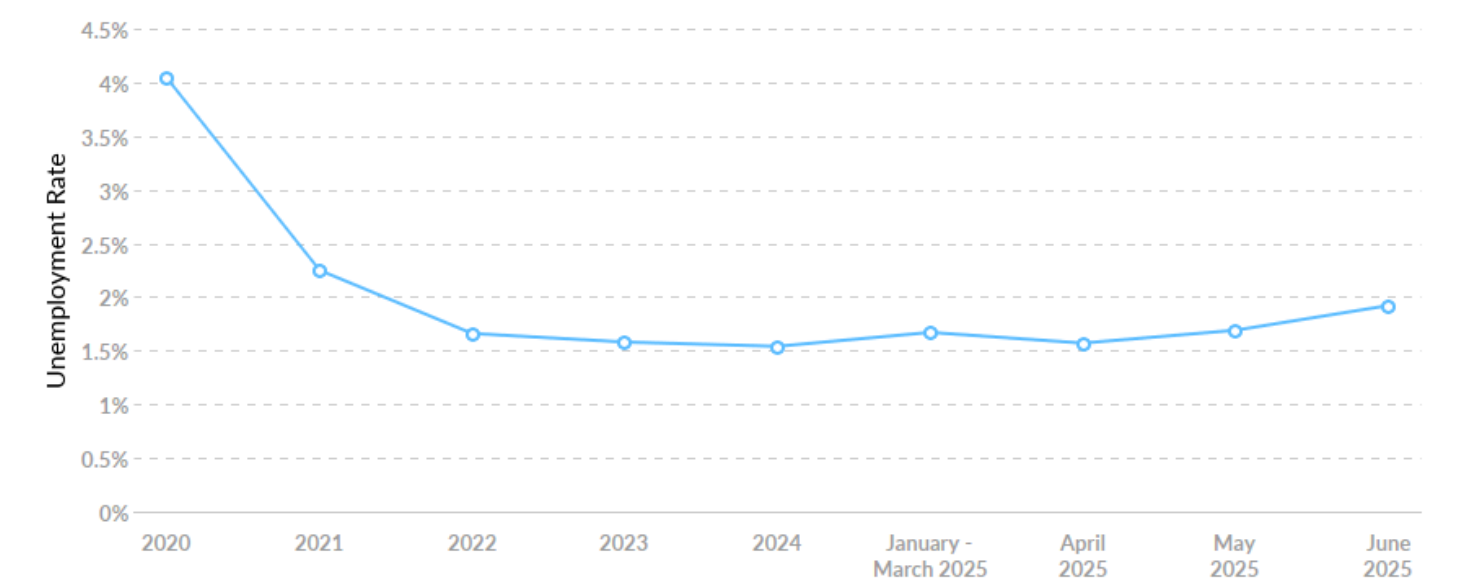

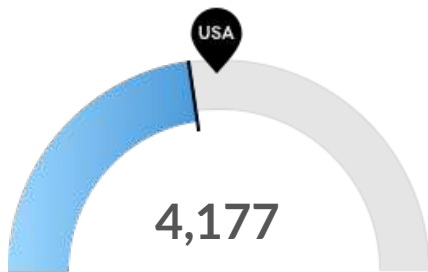
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Yankton County, SD had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 1.92%, **decreasing from 4.04%** 5 years before.



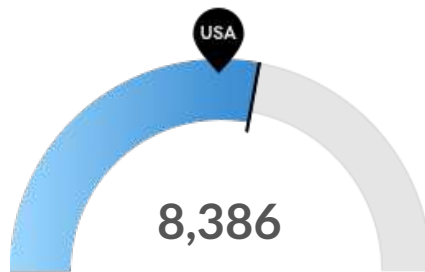

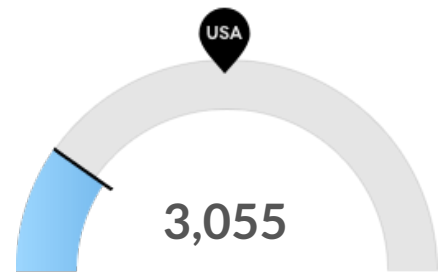
**Millennials**

Yankton County, SD has 4,177 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,778.



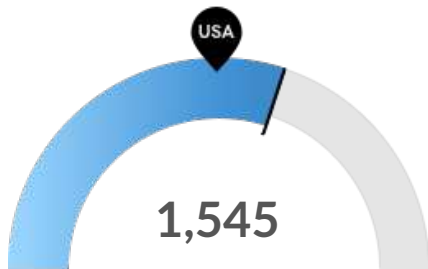
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Yankton County, SD. The national average for an area this size is 7,099 people 55 or older, while there are 8,386 here.



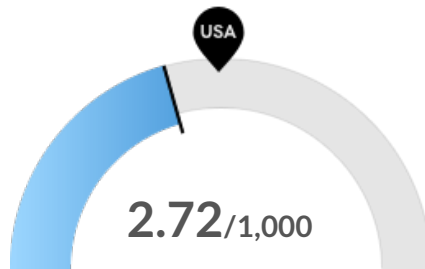
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Yankton County, SD. The national average for an area this size is 9,794 racially diverse people, while there are 3,055 here.



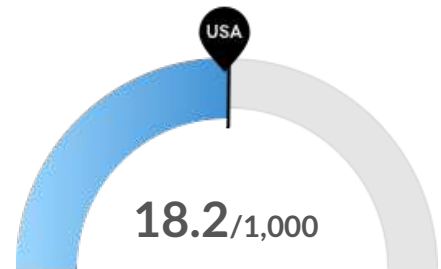
**Veterans**

Yankton County, SD has 2.72 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

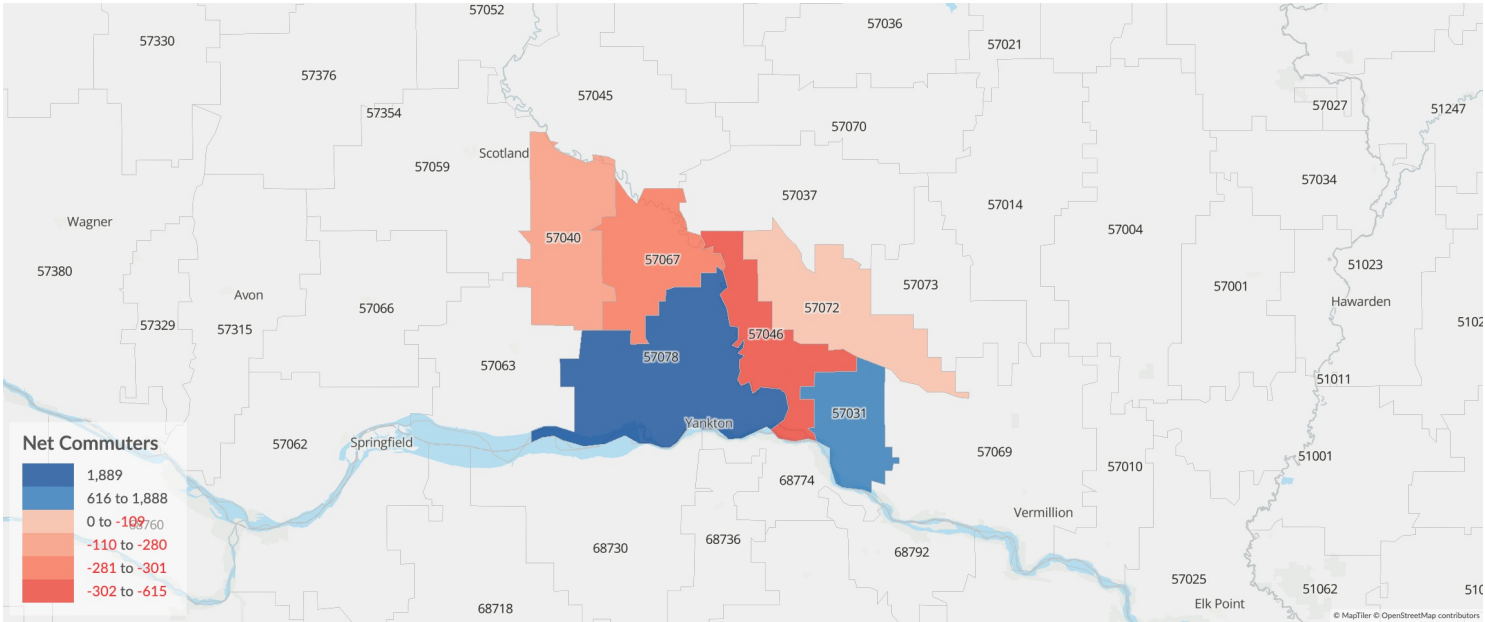


**Property Crime**

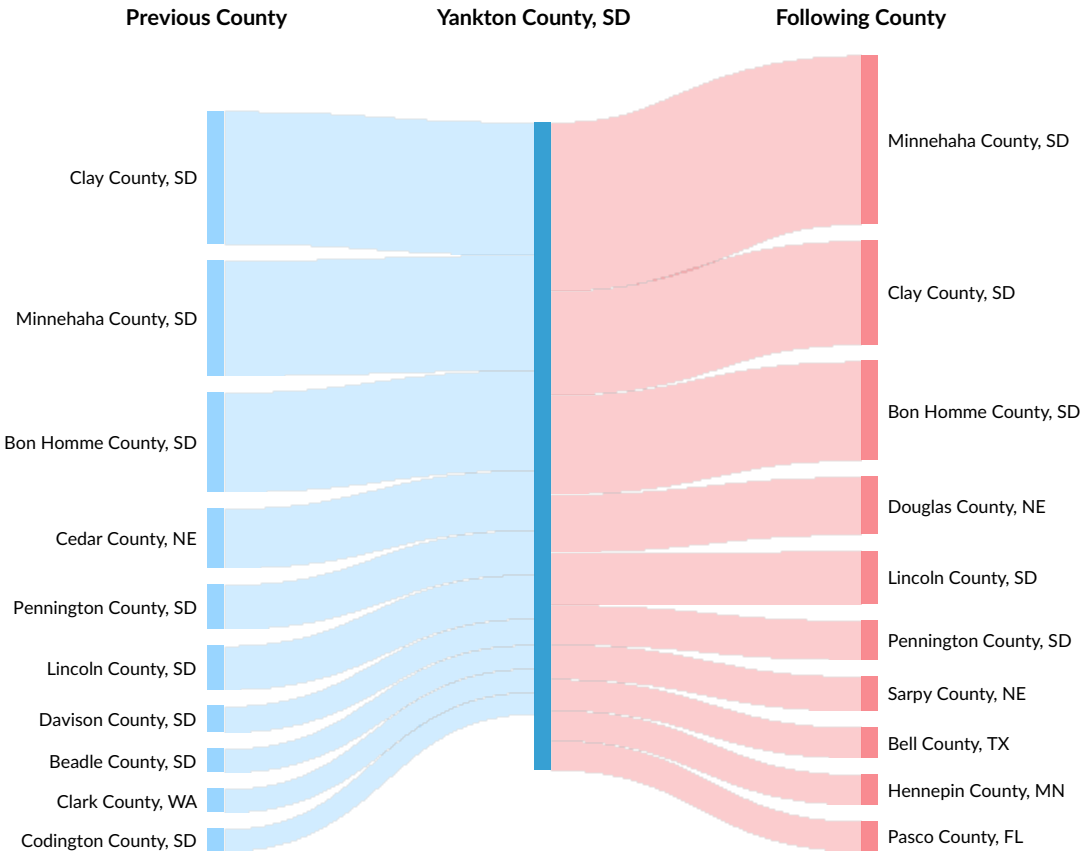

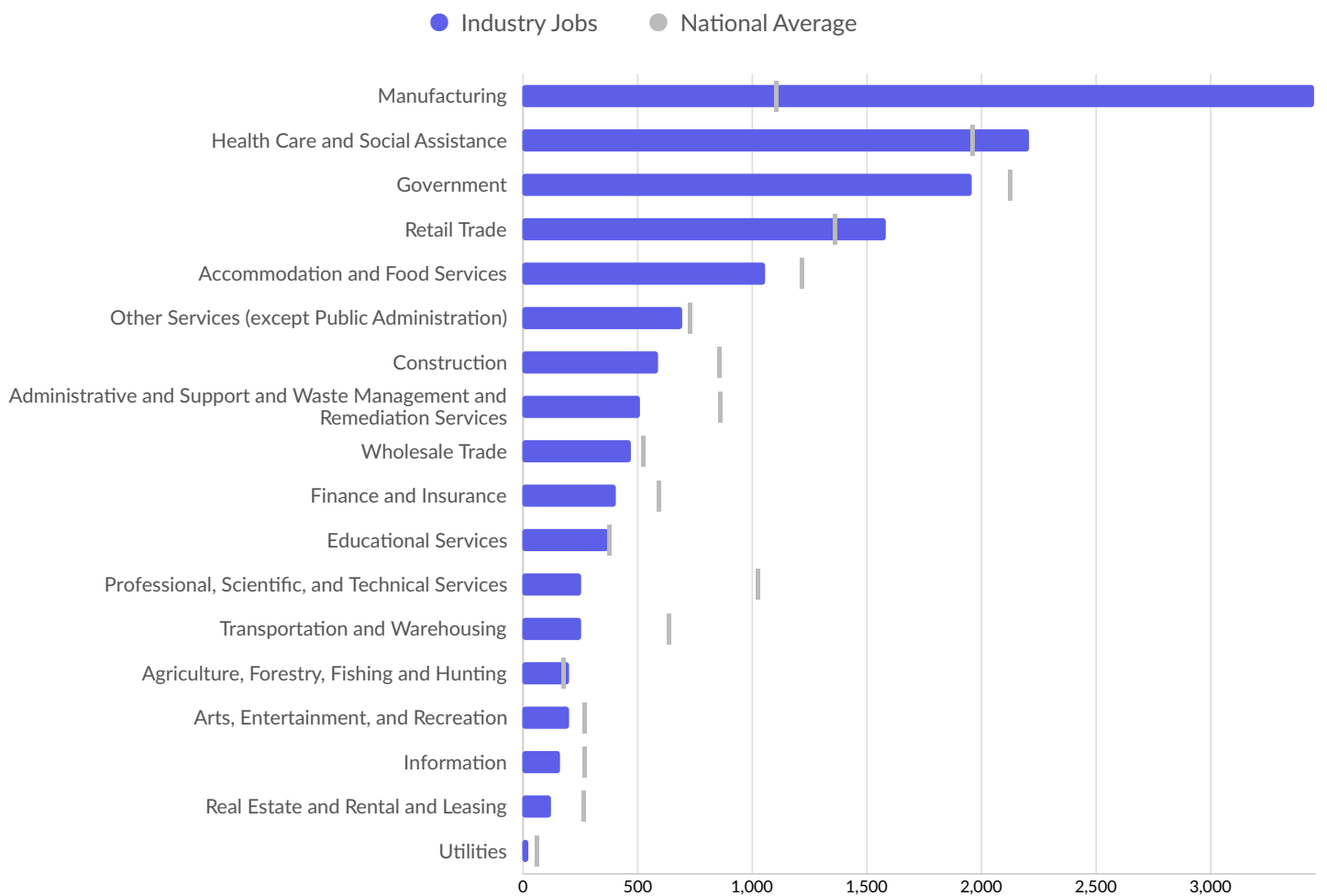

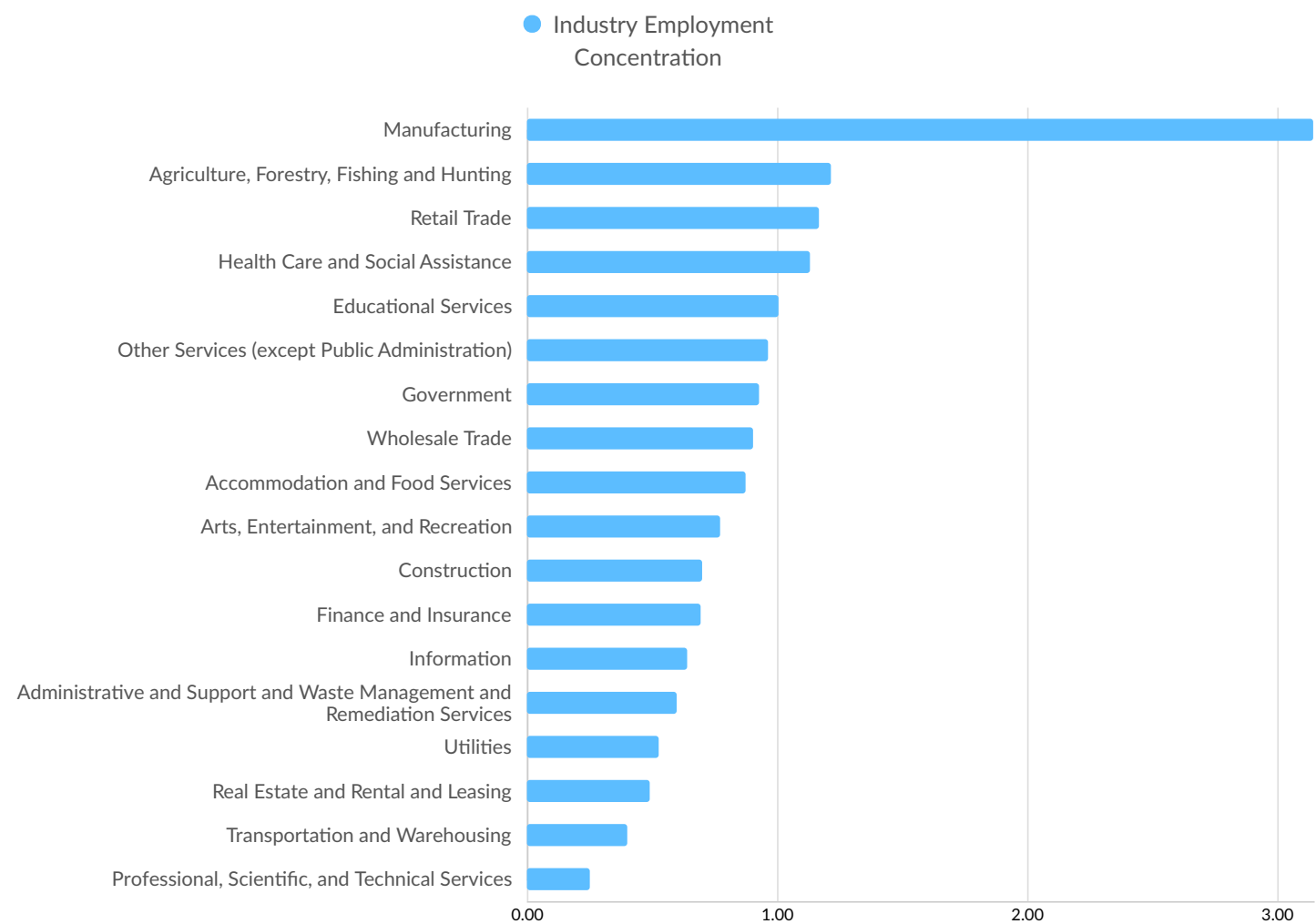

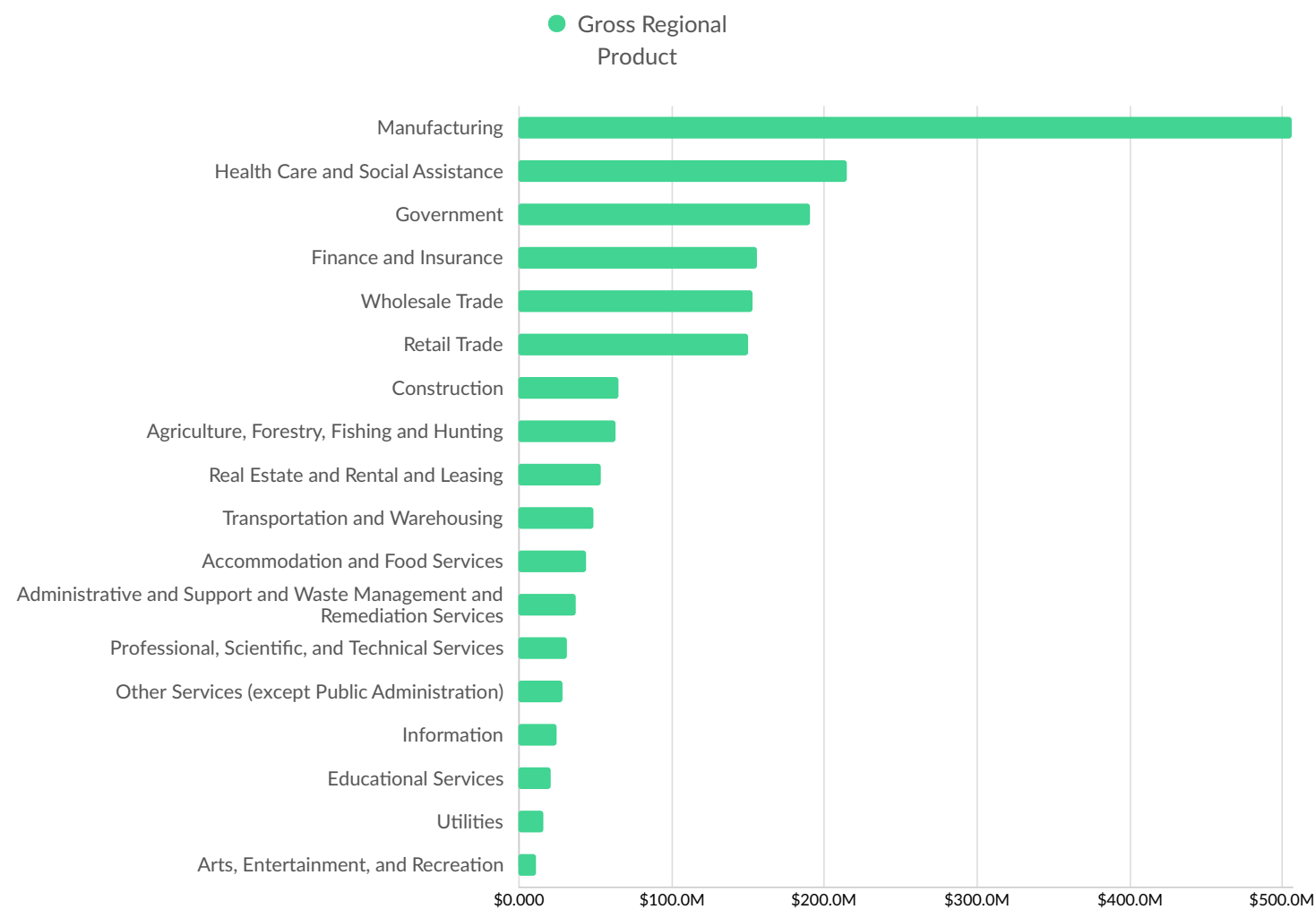

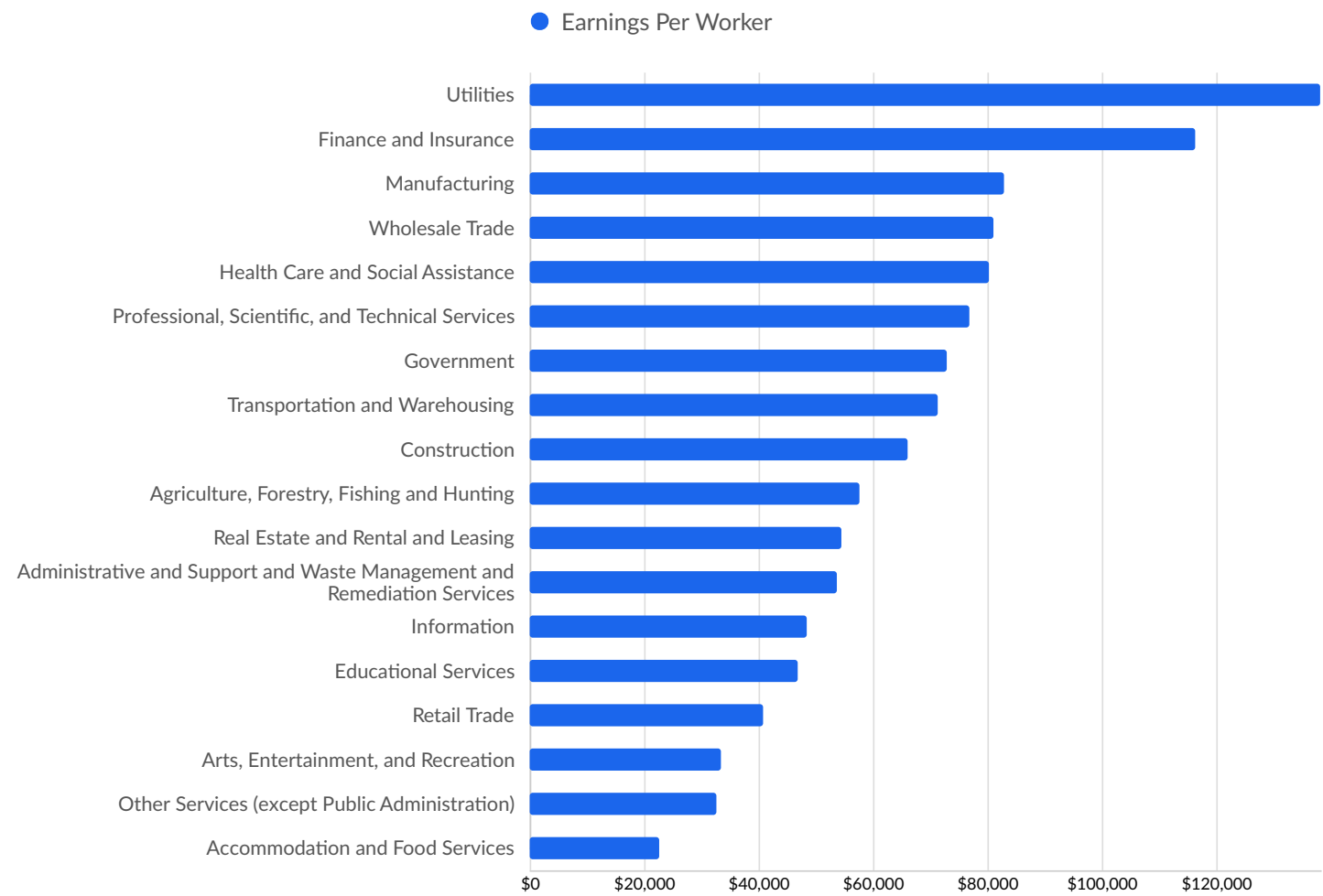
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

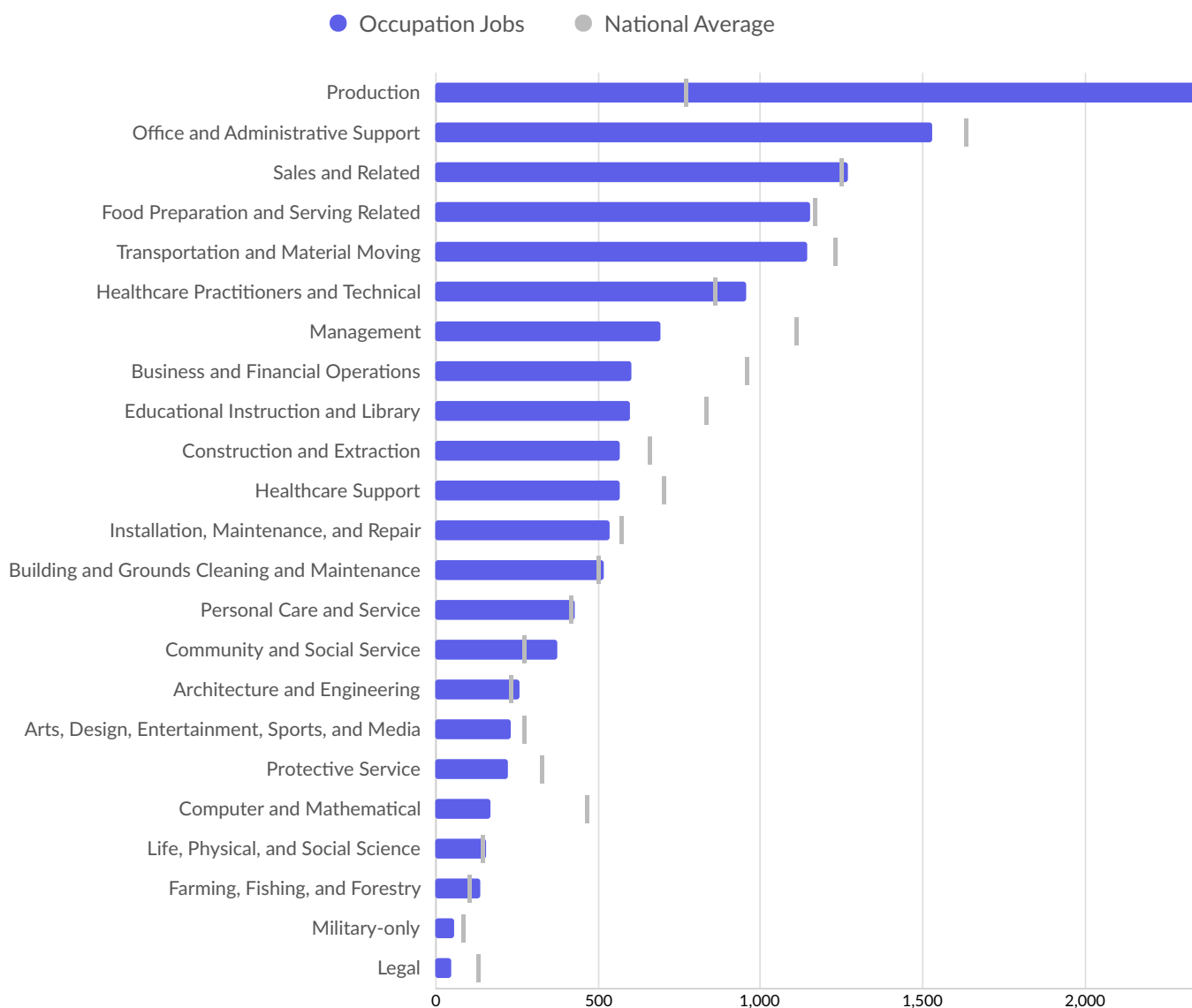

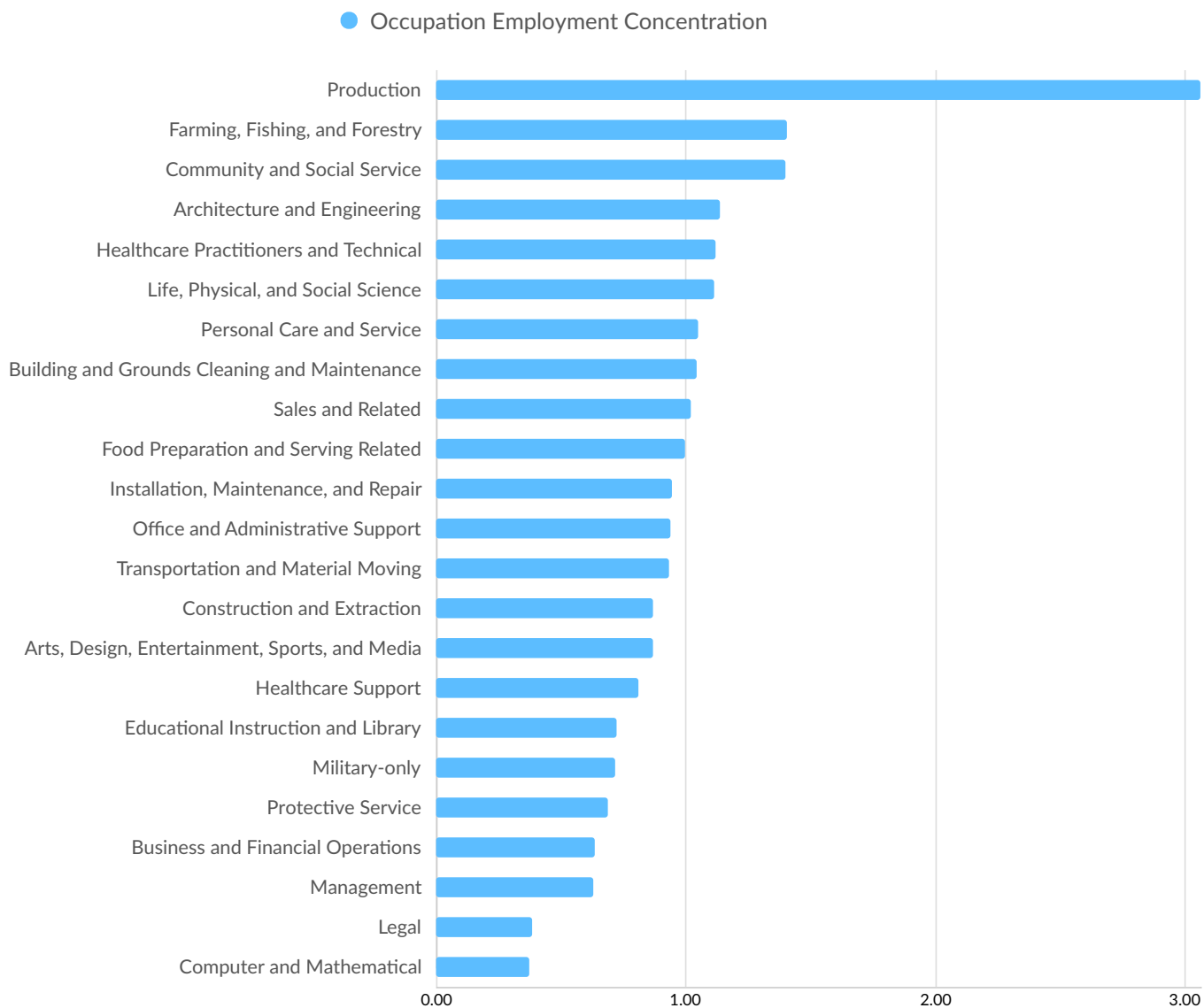
## Largest Occupations



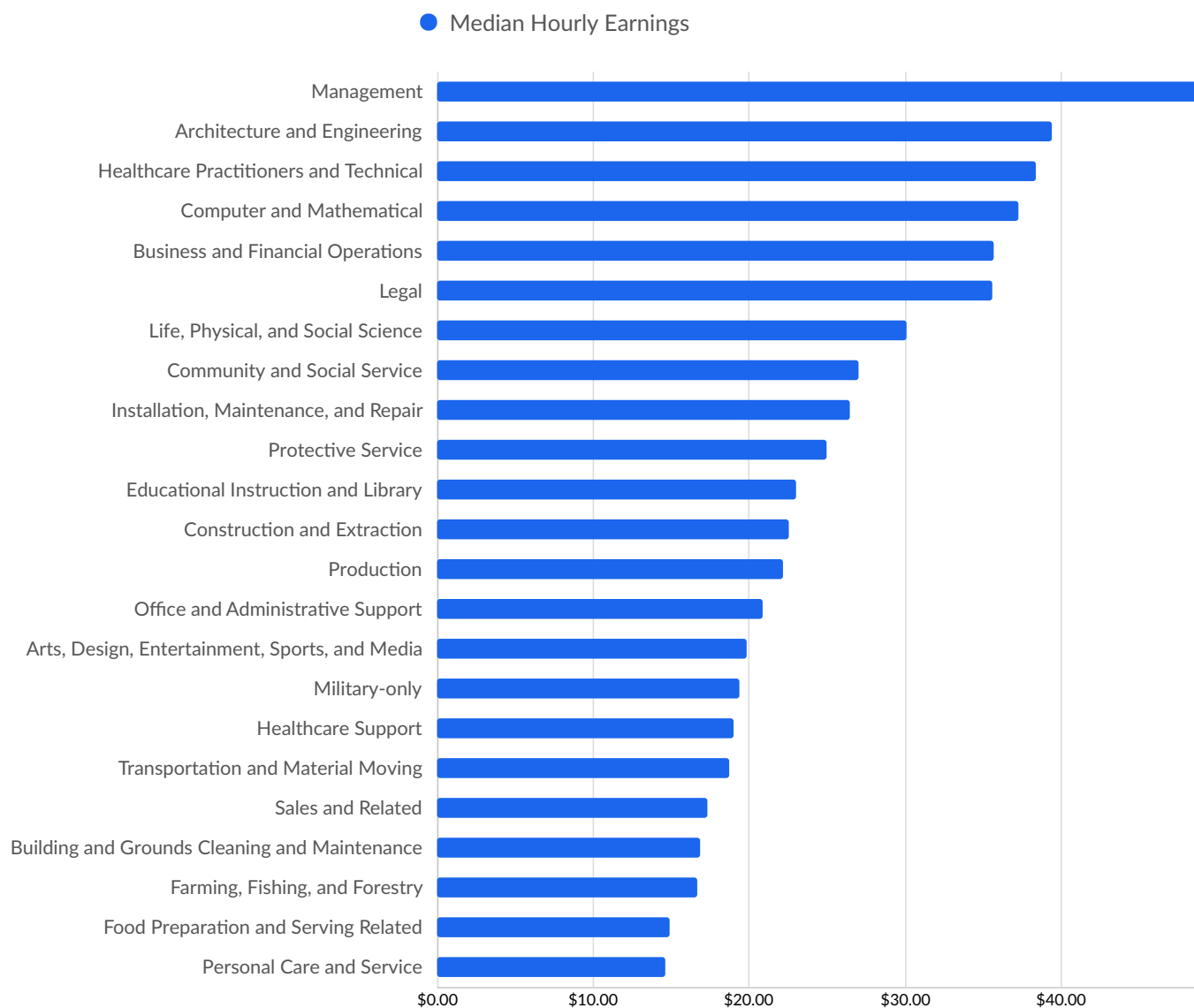
## Top Growing Occupations



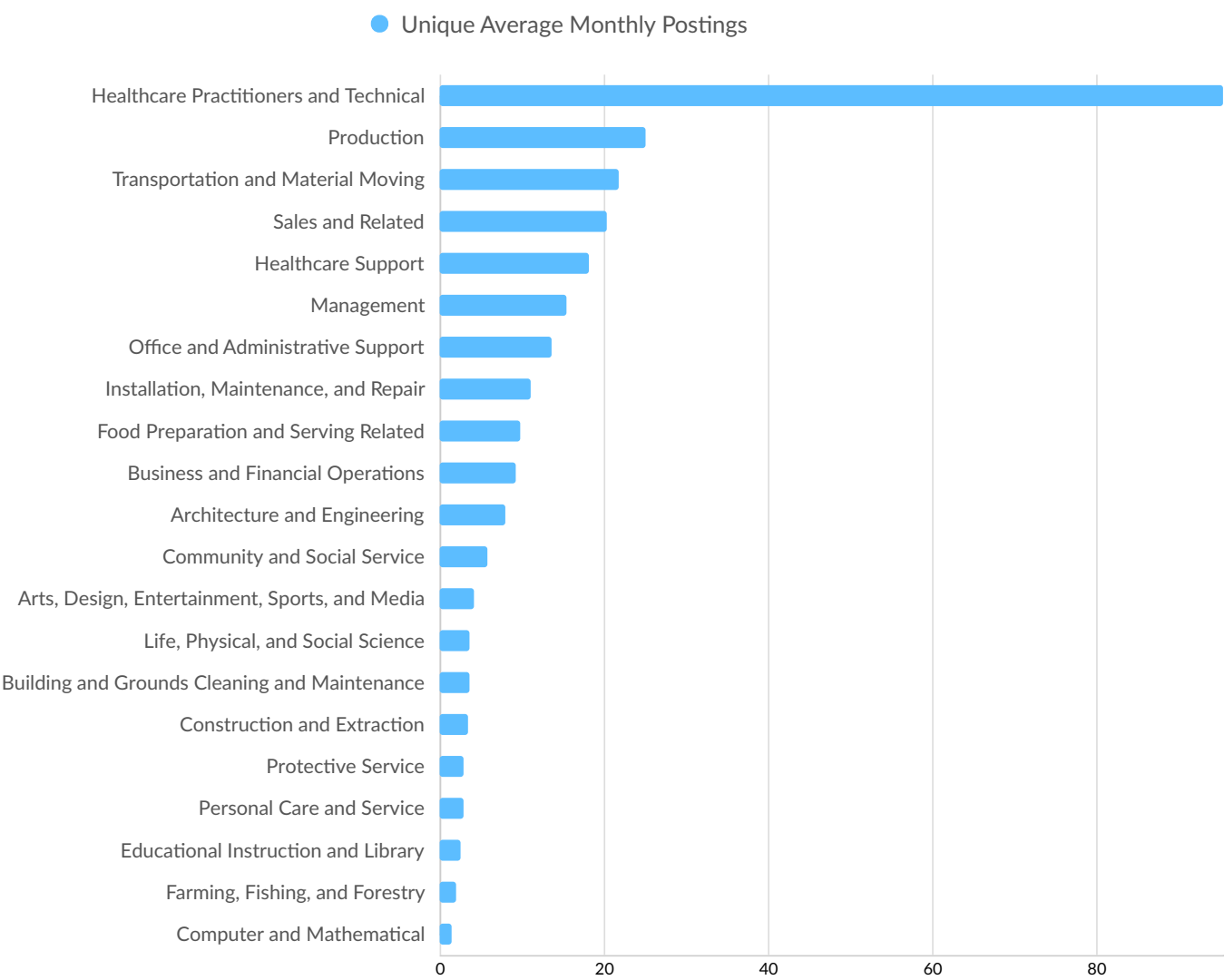
## Top Occupation Employment Concentration



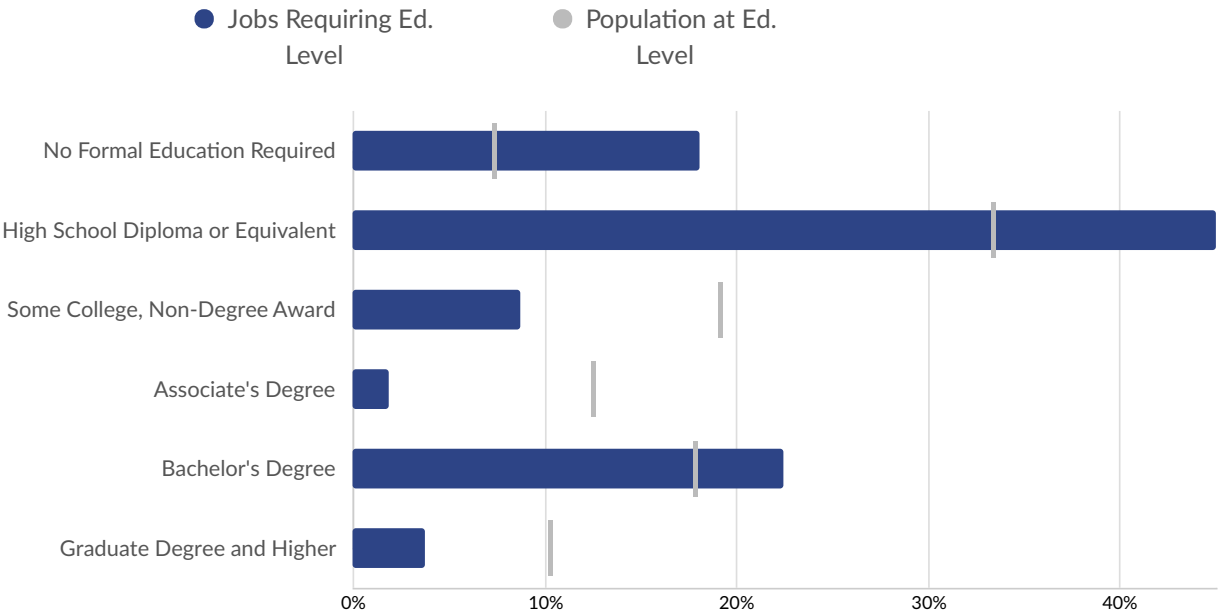

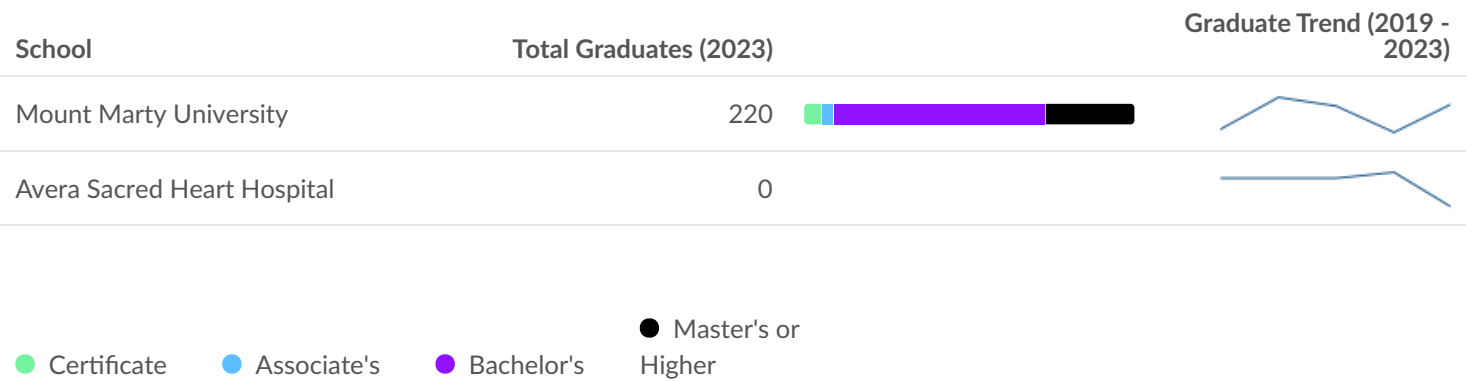
