Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 3.7% since 2019, growing by 854. Population is expected to increase by 2.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 566.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 2.0% in Yankton County, SD from 14,305 to 14,597. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 70.9% to 69.1% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.7% of Yankton County, SD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.8% below the national average), and **12.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends





Unemployment Rate Trends


Yankton County, SD had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 1.92%, decreasing from 4.04% 5 years before.




Millennials

Yankton County, SD has 4,177 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,778.




Veterans

Yankton County, SD has 1,545 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,163.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Yankton County, SD. The national average for an area this size is 7,099 people 55 or older, while there are 8,386 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Yankton County, SD. The national average for an area this size is 9,794 racially diverse people, while there are 3,055 here.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP



Top Occupation Employment Concentration












Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 220 graduates in Yankton County, SD. This pipeline has grown by 9% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nurse Anesthetist" (Master's or Higher), "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Bachelor's), and "Business Administration and Management, General" (Bachelor's).
